- Partnerships for the goals #17


Creation of a **culture of peace**. Transmission of :


PROVIDED TO PARTNER ORGANIZATIONS, THE PEACEMAKERS

Our methodology has been recognized as an innovative digital solution by the UN Secretary-General









1 - Capacity Building

 Creation of a pedagogical path for Peace through Sport Animators, including video tutorials

2 - Pedagogical Engineering

• +300 exercises available in 3 languages constantly evolving taking into account feedback from the ground

3 - Project Management

 Mentoring of local coordinators in charge of the implementation and planning of the activities

4 - Impact Management

- Activities reporting via the Mobile App
- Collaboration with the University of Paris-Nanterre to measure the impact of specific peace through sport

5 - Advocacy & Communication

- Support for peace messages
- Champions for Peace inspiration to youth
- Events : Friendship Games

6 - Coalition of Actors

- Developpement of a coalition approach
- Building bridges between sport, developpement and peace decision-makers

7 - Athletes Support

- Promotion of the committed athlete
- Testimony and connection with the ecosystem
- Active contribution on the field

- Winners are an **inspiration** to other stakeholders


Socrates Award - Ballon d'Or







- Collaboration between Peace and Sport and **L'Equipe** Group to create a societal award presented at the **Ballon d'Or** ceremony, the most prestigious individual trophy awarded in the world of Football
- Acknowledge the commitment off the pitch of a player
- 2022 Laureate: Sadio Mane
- 2023 Laureate: Vinicius Junior
- Media Coverage:
 - Over 100 media covering the event in 16 countries (TV, newspapers, radio, web)

April 6 was declared the International Day of Sport for Development and Peace by the 2012 **United Nations General Assembly**, with the support of the International Olympic Committee, and has been celebrated annually since 2014.


WHAT DOES PEACE AND **SPORT DO ON APRIL 6?**



Bring together representatives from various sectors including governments, international sports movement, international organizations, civil society and private sector (+4.500 delegates, + 450 speakers)


